

Status of ITER Negotiations



Status of Negotiations on ITER Site

- Six parties asked Host candidates to find solution to site issue
- EU and JA exchanged serious proposals and continue highlevel bilateral talks
 - EU proposes starting political discussions
 - JA proposes continuing technical discussions
 - Leaders of France and Japan meet later this month
- No six-party meeting scheduled yet



Status of International Agreement

- Interagency discussions renewed to develop detailed U.S. positions on the Agreement
 - Treaty or Executive Agreement or other legal document
 - Process, strategy and content for each open issue
- Seek understanding of ITER Parties' Domestic Agreement Requirements
 - E.g., in the US, H.R. 610 language of 120-day Congressional review of initialed Agreement
- Determine process for ITER Agreement Ratification and Entry into Force

FY 2005 U.S. ITER Preparations of \$5M

- Using FY05 \$5M to continue to get ready for MIE project
 - Maintaining U.S. visiting experts
 - Further establishing U.S. ITER Project Office
 - Fulfilling DOE project management requirements (DOE 413.3)
 - CD-0 Approve Mission Need (March 2005)
 Statement recently revised to reflect FY2006 President's Budget
 - CD-1 Approve Alternate Selection and Cost Range (June 2005)
 •Lehman Review scheduled March 22-24
 - CDs-2-4 are more dependent upon the reviews by the ITER Organization (to be formed) and by international reviews involving all six ITER parties.
 - Continuing technical activities for U.S. "in-kind" components
- New Secretary of Energy, Dr. Samuel W. Bodman, engaged
 - Participated in recent US/Japan high-level discussion on ITER held in DOE HQ, Washington, DC
 - Requested a comprehensive briefing on ITER
