Chinese official to tour France's site for ITER project

PARIS (AFP) - China's deputy science minister, Yan Hua-Liu, will visit France's proposed site for the future international energy project ITER, the ministry of research said here Monday.

Yan will tour the site at Cadarache, southern France, on Saturday, officials said.

Cadarache is bidding against the Japanese village of Rokkasho-Mura to host ITER.

France's bid has drawn the support of the European Union (news - web sites) (EU), Russia and China, whereas Japan's is backed by the United States, Japan and Korea.

The ITER partners failed to choose the winning bid at a meeting in Washington on December 20 and a fresh meeting has been set for next month
