## **NSO Studies - FY2002**

- The FY02 effort will focus on two tasks:
  - 1. Continue pre-conceptual design work on FIRE.
  - 2. Support the assessment work for the 2002 Fusion Summer Study at Snowmass.
- The NSO budget for FY02 has been increased from \$2.2M to \$3.1M (as recommended by FESAC).
