By letter dated May 13, 2013, you notified the Committee of the Department of Energy's intent to reprogram \$147,096,094 within the Office of Science to address cuts resulting from sequestration and \$80,279,193 within the Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewably Energy to move funds misaligned as a result of the fiscal year 2013 continuing resolution. Pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Consolidated and Further Continuing Appropriations Act, 2013, the Department of Energy may not use these funds to initiate or resume any project or activity for which appropriations, funds, or other authority was not available during fiscal year 2012.

The Committee has no objection to the proposed reprogramming for the Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy, and approves the reprogramming for the Office of Science under the stipulation that the Department does not implement shutdown of the Alcator C-Mod Facility at Massachusetts Institute of Technology as proposed in the reprogramming request.
